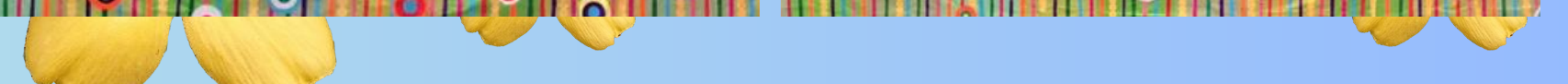
World Penguin Day

Vivekananda Jayanti

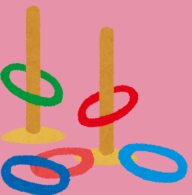

Staff Picnic

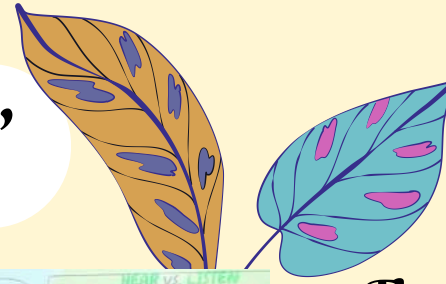

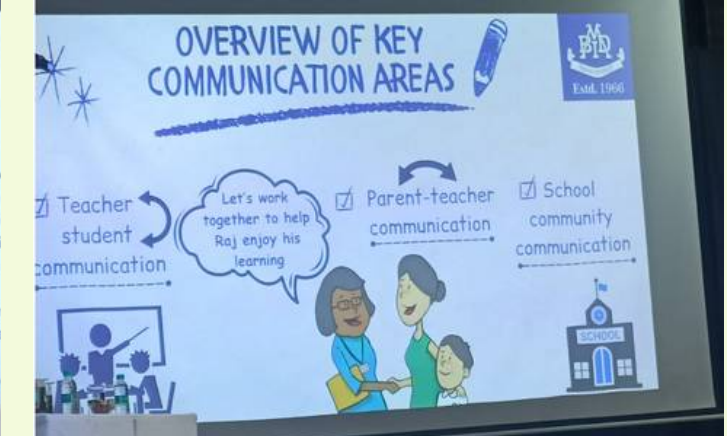
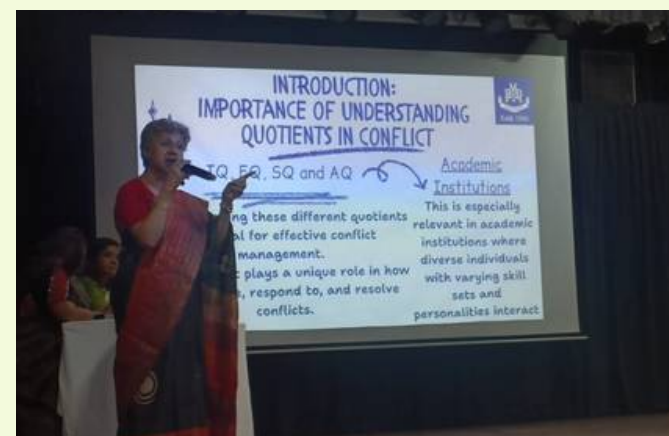
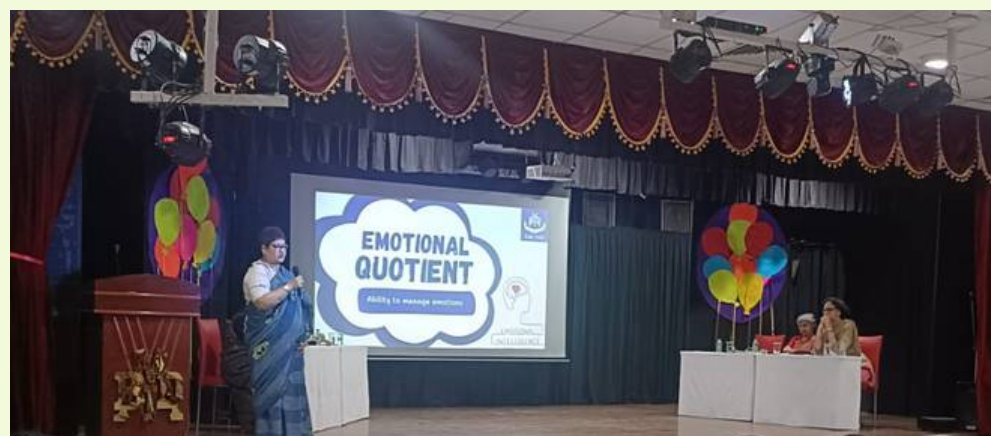


Zumba and yoga workshops were held on 15.02.2025 and 19.02.2024 for the teachers to enhance their mental and physical well being.

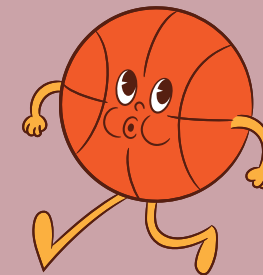
March Past

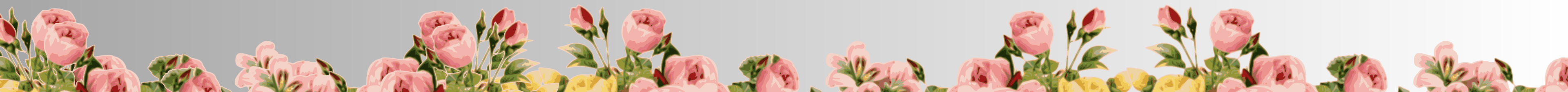
